REPORT

On 27th October, 2023 (Friday), amidst the festive season the Department of Geography, St. Xavier's Collge, Burdwan organized an online extension lecture by Dr. Taneesha Devi Mohan, Assistant Professor, Department of Geography, University of Colorado, Boulder, USA. The academic session took place through Google Meet Application using the link https://meet.google.com/zd-osmo-zhb from 10.00 hours (IST). The topic of the session was Routes to Food Security: Strategies of India and Bangladesh. As many as 65 participants attended the session.

Dr. Mohan's insights were not only enlightening but also thought provoking as she revealed the plight and regular struggles of women engaged in various roles in agricultural economy in West Bengal and Bangladesh. She elucidated through her extensive field work how in different parts of West Bengal and Bangladesh social constraints like casteism, racial and religious discriminations impose hindrance towards food security. Women who are directly associated with agricultural process seemed to be most deprived in terms of food procurement, health and sanitation parameters, social interaction and general standard of living. She also focused on the efficacies governmental initiatives to improve the situation. It came up through her vivid descriptions that women in agriculture become victims of vicious cycle of multi-dimensional poverty which is difficult to surpass in the given social and political ecology of both the countries which are heavily dependent on agriculture as a prime economic activity.

The lecture was followed by an interactive session where several social issues aggravating the deprivation of agricultural women were brought to forefront. The lecture invoked a sense of understanding of agrarian social constraints to which the young participants pledged to work o for a sustainable future.




Plate 1: Key concept of the lecture
