
#### **GREEN INITIATIVES**






# Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)



#### **AUDIT**

#### ACADEMIC AND ADMINISTRATIVE AUDIT

26 February 2024



On February 26, 2024, St. Xavier's College, Burdwan underwent a comprehensive Academic Audit by the auditing team from the University of Burdwan. The audit covered the period from the academic year 2018 to 2023, evaluating various aspects of our educational practices, administrative procedures, and overall institutional performance. The auditing team, comprising seasoned educators administrative experts, meticulously reviewed our academic programs, faculty qualifications, teaching methodologies, student assessments, infrastructure, and adherence to regulatory standards. Their objective was to assess the effectiveness of our academic operations and ensure alignment with the university's guidelines and national educational standards. Throughout the audit process, our college demonstrated a commitment to transparency and excellence in education. The baseline data was prepared by IQAC and the content of the baseline data containing data mentioned in the Department Profile of the eight departments (including two professional courses) was verified by the Expert Team for validity and reliability. The team conducted interviews with faculty members, administrative staff, and students to gather diverse perspectives on our educational practices and institutional climate. They scrutinized academic records, course syllabi, examination results, and feedback mechanisms to gauge the quality of our educational offerings and the

overall learning experience. We look forward to integrating the audit recommendations into our strategic planning and operational framework to foster continued growth and success.

#### ENERGY AUDIT

St. Xavier's College, Burdwan, recently underwent energy audits conducted by the **West Bengal State Electricity Distribution Company Limited (W.B.S.E.D.C.L)** and experts from The University of Burdwan. These audits aimed to analyze the college's energy consumption and propose strategies for enhancing energy efficiency.

The audit by experts from the University of Burdwan provided a comprehensive analysis of both electrical and structural aspects of the campus.

The W.B.S.E.D.C.L audit focused on the college's electrical infrastructure, identifying areas where energy consumption could be reduced.

Both audits underscored the significant potential for energy savings at St. Xavier's College. By implementing the proposed measures, the college can achieve considerable cost savings and contribute to environmental sustainability.

#### GENDER AUDIT






#### **Add-on-Courses**


