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Plan for Institutional Infrastructure Development and Institution Expansion

Short-Term Action Plan

- 1. Infrastructure Development:**
 - Complete construction of Academic building, Administrative building, and Annex building by 2018-2019.
 - Purchase 23 khatas of land within the campus for future expansion.
- 2. Facilities Enhancement:**
 - Develop green covers, internal roads, paths, and gardens for aesthetic appeal.
 - Construct modern store rooms behind the academic building.
 - Establish an organic kitchen garden.
- 3. Student Accommodation:**
 - Provide basic accommodation facilities for outstation students (both boys and girls).
- 4. Academic and Course Expansion:**
 - Obtain permanent affiliation from the University of Burdwan.
 - Introduce professional courses like BBA and BCA.
 - Obtain permission to introduce PG Courses like MA in English.
- 5. Skill Development and Certificates:**
 - Introduce certificate courses in Tally, Spoken English, Yoga, and European languages like French, Italian and Spanish etc.
- 6. Institutional Framework Strengthening:**
 - Establish IQAC (Internal Quality Assurance Cell) and other necessary committees for governance.
 - Form various statutory and non-statutory cells for student welfare and governance.
- 7. Cultural and Academic Enrichment:**
 - Create associations and clubs for year-round activities and events.
- 8. Mission and Educational Goals:**
 - Develop a comprehensive mission statement in line with Jesuit Higher Education traditions.
 - Align the college's vision with the principles of Jesuit Mission West Bengal and St. Xavier's Burdwan Educational Trust.
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- 9. Collaborations and Partnerships:**
 - Sign MOUs with affiliated colleges, industries, yoga centers, hospitals, NGOs, and environmental organizations for enhanced learning and exposure opportunities.
- 10. Extended Course Offerings:**
 - Obtain extended affiliation from the Government and University to introduce courses in Mass Communication and Journalism, and Economics.



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Long-Term Action Plan

Objective: To strategically plan and execute the expansion and enhancement of infrastructure for the college, focusing on acquiring land for future development and establishing hostel facilities for students.

1. Land Acquisition for Expansion

3. Strategic Implementation Approach

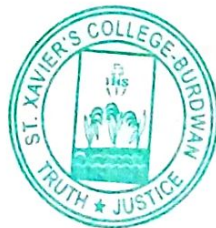
- **Phase-wise Execution:**

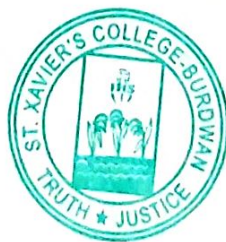
Strategic Plan for Developing the Teaching-Learning Process and Infrastructure

Short-Term Action Plan
