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Teaching- Learning Process

St. Xavier's College, Burdwan has garnered acclaim for its innovative approach to education, tailored to meet the needs of contemporary learners. Faculty members utilize ICT-enabled tools extensively, including online resources and digital technology integrated into teaching practices across the campus.

The college boasts partially Wi-Fi-enabled premises with smart classrooms equipped with projectors, smart-boards, and sound systems. Additional facilities like audio-visual rooms, seminar halls, and a multipurpose hall are utilized for interactive and experiential learning sessions.
