REPORT ACADEMIC EXCURSION TO SUKARDANGA VILLAGE: 2018-2019

Department of Sociology has been organizing annual educational trips every year with the the objective of giving the students a round exposure to build a bridge between the theory and practical.

This year the department took the students to a field trip to **SUKURDANGA** a village in Burdwan, on 17th November 2018, which comprises of one of the Santhal belt in West Bengal. The main focus was to give the students a practical knowledge of what and how fieldwork is done in Sociology as this benefitted all the years for their further pursuits and the 1st and 2nd years as field trip and dissertation writing was part of their university Curriculum. This field trip helped transform the data collected into a field report, taught students to work with qualitative and quantitative data and their research tools focused on the societal structure, culture, and government policies for the tribal inhabitants; also effects of modernization and westernization on their aboriginal customs.
