REPORT ON QUIZ: GEO-QUEST

On the occasion of the World Environment Day, June 5, 2020, the department held an online quiz competition named *"Geo-Quest"*. The Department in its endeavour to make young minds aware of the Environment—natural and social attempts to go beyond the textbook curriculum so that academically inquisitive minds can explore their knowledge and awareness on the world we live in had organized this quiz contest. The quiz targeted two groups—School students from standard IX to XII and the second one was open to the academia in general.

The Department used Google Forms to conduct the quiz. There was a limited time frame from 10 in the morning to 10.30 in the night. There had been no registration fees and certificates were provided to the successful participants.

The responses were truly overwhelming. In the school level quiz there were 131 participants. In the general quiz there were 520 participants—making a total of 651 participants overall.

In the school level quiz there were participants throughout West Bengal, India and abroad. We received two participants from East Timor and Dubai. Students from these schools enthusiastically participated in the quiz and showed great interest in the humble academic endeavour of the department. We have been successfully reached out to almost all the 23 districts of West Bengal and other important cities of India as participants from all these places had taken the quiz.

The quiz open to the general environment enthusiasts included school, college and university faculties, under graduate and post graduate students from varied disciplines along with Geography, M.Phil. and Ph.D. research scholars and several other professionals. There had been as many as 70 school and college and university faculties; 50 participants from various other professionals and 400 under graduate and post graduate students including the students of the Geography Department, St. Xavier's College, Burdwan; along with M.Phil. and Ph.D. research scholars.

All the participants could successfully complete the quiz and E-certificates were distributed by June 10, 2020. The participant's feedback was very encouraging.

Reaching out to the pan Indian academia through this environmental knowledge based quiz contest is indeed a great achievement for the Department of Geography, St. Xavier's College, Burdwan. It did leave remarkable signature of academic pursuit which is a continuous responsibility of the Department.

REPORT ON ESSAY WRITING COMPETITION: GEO-LIT

The most active, creative young generation remained confined to four walls during the COVID-19 lockdown. In order to seek free flow of thoughts, imagination and creativity, The Department of Geography, St. Xavier's College, Burdwan provided a platform where creative articulation in form of essay confluences with sound environmental awareness. It intended to bring out such latent thoughts to reality and seek ideas from budding Geographers to combat the fight against COVID-19 amidst home confinement. Through this endeavour the Department showcased its ever encouraging objective to urge young minds to put their thoughts into words.

The essay writing competition was titled "Geo-Lit". This competition was held in three tiers—School level (standard IX-XII od any stream); Under Graduate Level having Geography Honours as well as General and Post Graduate students of Geography. Each category had five choices of exclusive topics for writing the essay. These topics were related to Environmental Geography pertaining to the bio-hazard COVID-19. Geo-Lit had a focal theme: COVID-19—Images of the Pandemic: A Geo – Environmental Synthesis. There were specific rules set up for the essay contest. There was a also rigorous anti-plagiarism regulation. Evaluation of the essay was done in two tiers—primary screening on the basis of plagiarism check performed by software named Plagiarism Checker X. More than 10% of similarity found with the internet sources were disqualified for further evaluation. In the second tier of evaluation there were specific and objective criteria with relevant weightages. These judging criteria are as follows:

Each entry received was codified for blind-review. The essays were sent to five evaluators who held the position of Ph.D. research scholars, College teachers and School teachers in premier institutes of India.

•All entries must be original and unpublished. Plagiarism is a serious academic offence. Plagiarized entries over 10-12% similarity shall be disqualified


